Epeus has formed two new operating companies in Nigeria to support our existing Client base and secure new business in the onshore and offshore oil and gas sector in West Africa, from our new office in Port Harcourt.

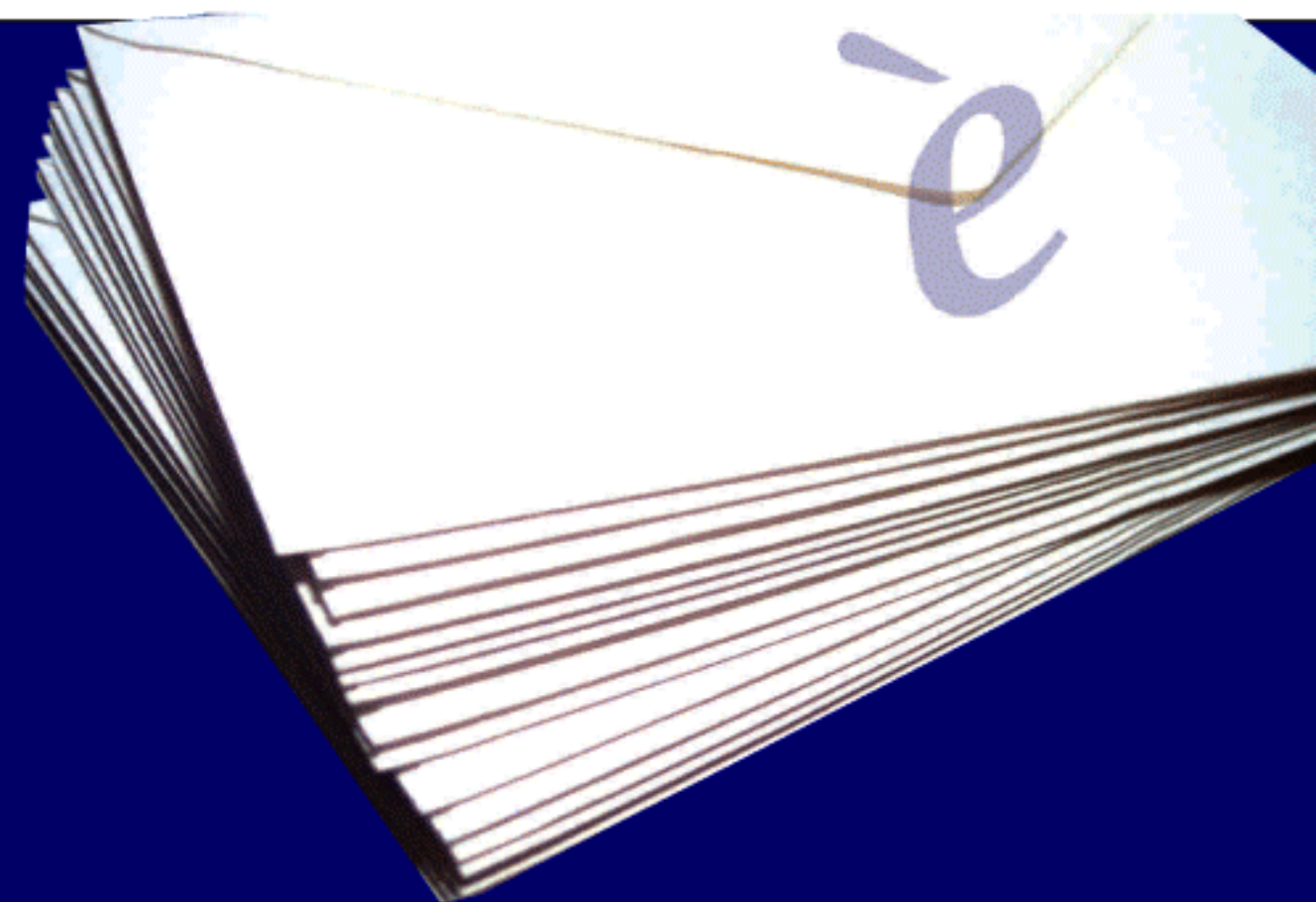
The 'Searex VI' is a non-propelled drilling swamp barge with a 100 berth capacity accommodation block, which Transocean has sold to Frazimex. Work on the vessel will commence in October 2006, duration 6 months. The initial phase of the works will be executed at the dry-dock in Cameroon, before the vessel is towed to our technical partner (PW Resource Shore Base) in Rumuolumeni, Port Harcourt for reactivation.

- è The belief, loyalty and commitment shown by all – customers, employees, contract staff, suppliers and associates alike without which none of the great things we have achieved to date would have been possible.

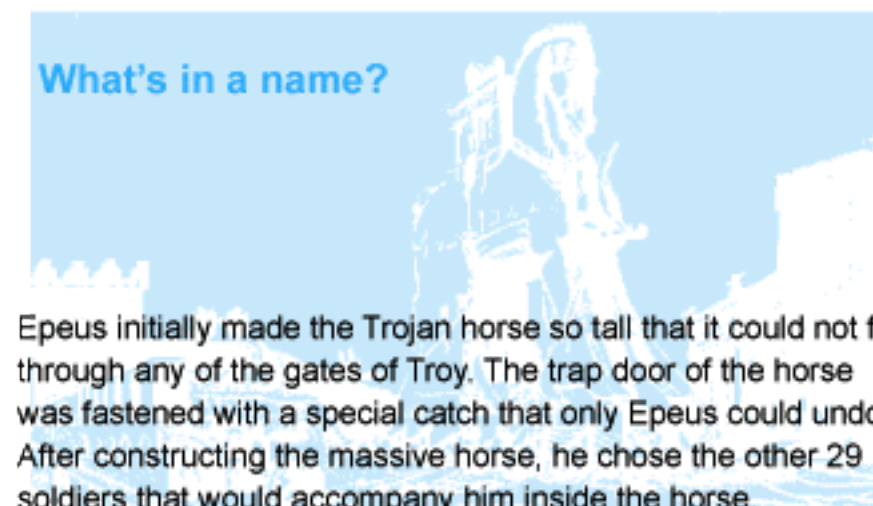

Transocean

Sedco 700 & J Cunningham Projects

Epeus are providing the project management and coordination of the above two projects. The Sedco 700 will be executed in Equatorial Guinea and is set to last through to 2nd Quarter 2007. The Jim Cunningham project will be planned and executed in Nigeria with the expected completion date being the second quarter of 2007.

Sedco 709 Draws to a close

The Sedco 709 project is drawing to a close. The Rig was taken to Cape Town for significant steel replacement work and thrusters over hauls. Epeus have provided project engineering support to Transocean since November 2005 with the team having spent the last four months in Cape Town. Epeus also provided risk assessment support on this project through our success enabler service.

Epeus has been awarded a consultancy contract to analyse well completion and extended well test (EWT) scenarios on the Kessog development. The work involves identifying and analysing different options. The service provided is the edge enhancer which has been specifically designed to define project parameters within a risk management context.

Talisman

Talisman are bringing the Rowan Gorilla VI into the North Sea alongside the Arbroath production facility. Epeus are providing the project management and interface coordination of the project which is expected to complete by the end of 2006.

BP

Epeus has been engaged by BP Norway to provide project assurance services in support of rig building activities for the Skarv project. The rig will be constructed at Yantai Raffles shipyard in China. The ongoing project will involve our Houston, Singapore and Aberdeen offices through to 2008/2009

Odfjell

Epeus was contracted to supply independent project assurance services during the design phase of Odfjell's GVA 7500 at DSME Korea. Initially the work involves our evaluator Service on key drilling equipment suppliers.

USA.

Viking Producer

Epeus LLC (USA) has been awarded the project management team support of the Viking Producer in the Gulf of Mexico. The Viking Producer, currently a bare semi sub hull, will be converted to a drilling rig. The expected duration of the work is approximately 14 months.

South East Asia

Singapore – Molly Brown – pending approval

Epeus have had a project management team working with Compass Energy since late 2005 to define the Molly Brown upgrade and conversion project. Currently outfitted as a floating production unit the Molly Brown is to be converted into a 'state of the art' drilling rig capable of drilling in 8000ft water depth. Following completion of the preliminary work, the project is currently pending approval to proceed
